EVACUATION ALERT #13 Donnie Creek/Tommy Lakes Wildfire Electoral Area B

June 30, 2023 @ 16:30

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by Peace River Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC). BC Wildfire service has recommended an evacuation alert as a result of the Donnie Creek/Tommy Lakes wildfire (G80223). Evacuation Alert #13 replaces Evacuation Order #12. Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Peace River Regional District has issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following areas:

- From Mile 207 on Highway 97 North West to the Prophet River
- Southwest following the Prophet River for 14km to Milliken Creek
- From that point, continuing south easterly, maintaining approximately a 6 km buffer west of Hwy 97 N to a point of intersection of km 20 on the Pink Mountain Road (Halfway River)
- South east following Halfway River to the intersection of Boring Ranch Road and Cypress Creek Road
- South east and east to a point of intersection with Highway 97 N at km 177
- Heading north along Highway 97 to 1 km north of Tommy Lakes Road
- Turning north east within 1 km of the Tommy Lakes Road for 20 km
- From there heading due east to 3 km East of PDR 200 (North of Peejay)
- North to the headwaters and including the following creeks: West Milligan Creek, Big Arrow Creek, and Zarembo Creek
- South to a point 16 km due East of the intersection of the Black Creek and Beatton River
- Heading due west towards a point 6 km before mile 160 on the Alaska Highway
- Turning northeast along the Sikanni Chief River for 4 km
- Heading northwest for 44 km
- Then southeast towards Kirkpatrick Creek
- Then generally northeast towards Horse Range Creek
- Then northwest to Mile 207 to the Prophet River

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents, cell phone and charger and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you including pet care items (leash, carrier, food) and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles. If transportation assistance is needed, call 1-800-670-7773.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor www.prrd.bc.ca and Emergency Info BC for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres and hours of operation.

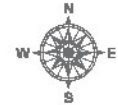

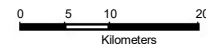
