



PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT EVACUATION ALERT

EVACUATION ALERT #2

Bearhole Lake Wildfire Electoral Area D

September 8, 2022 at 09:00hrs

At the recommendation of the BC Wildfire Service, the Evacuation Order, pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the BC Emergency Program Act issued on September 4, 2022 @ 16:00hrs to the area(s) of the Community of Kelly Lake, 4km West of the Alberta border, and 5km North of Kelly Lake until 5km South of Kelly Lake has been rescinded as of September 8, 2022 @ 09:00hrs. BC Wildfire Service has recommended an evacuation alert remain in place as a result of the Bearhole Lake Wildfire (G72178).

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Peace River Regional District has issued an Evacuation Alert for the area(s) of the Community of Kelly Lake, 4km West of the Alberta border, and 5km North of Kelly Lake until 5km South of Kelly Lake.

The Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions. A map of the evacuation alert area is provided below.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents, cell phone & charger and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you including pet care items (leash, carrier, food) and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- **Those with transportation, mobility, health, or other special needs can call 1-800-670-7773 for assistance.**
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor www.prrd.bc.ca and Emergency Info BC for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres and hours of operation. For up to date information, please visit the [BC Wildfire Service website](#).
