



EVACUATION ALERT #3
Kiskatinaw River Wildfire (G70422)
Electoral Area D
June 3, 2025, at 1 830

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by Peace River Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC). BC Wildfire Service has recommended this Alert due to the potential danger to life and health caused by the Kiskatinaw River Wildfire.

The **Evacuation Alert** is in effect for the following areas:

- From the junction of the One Island Lake Road due east to the BC Border
- Due South along the BC Border 10.5 KM
- Due 2 km west to the edge of Beaverlodge Lake
- Along the southern shore of Beaverlodge Lake .75km
- Due west to a point of intersection with Highway 52 east
- Due west 14.5 km to a point of intersection with One Island Lake Rd .5 km south of Noel Rd
- North along the One Island Lake Rd including all addresses listed below in the electoral area:

17290 213 Rd
17102 Hwy 52 E

17157 One Island Lake Rd

This is the time to GET PREPARED to leave your home on short notice.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation;



however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles. If transportation assistance is needed, call 1-800-670-7773.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor www.prrd.bc.ca for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres.

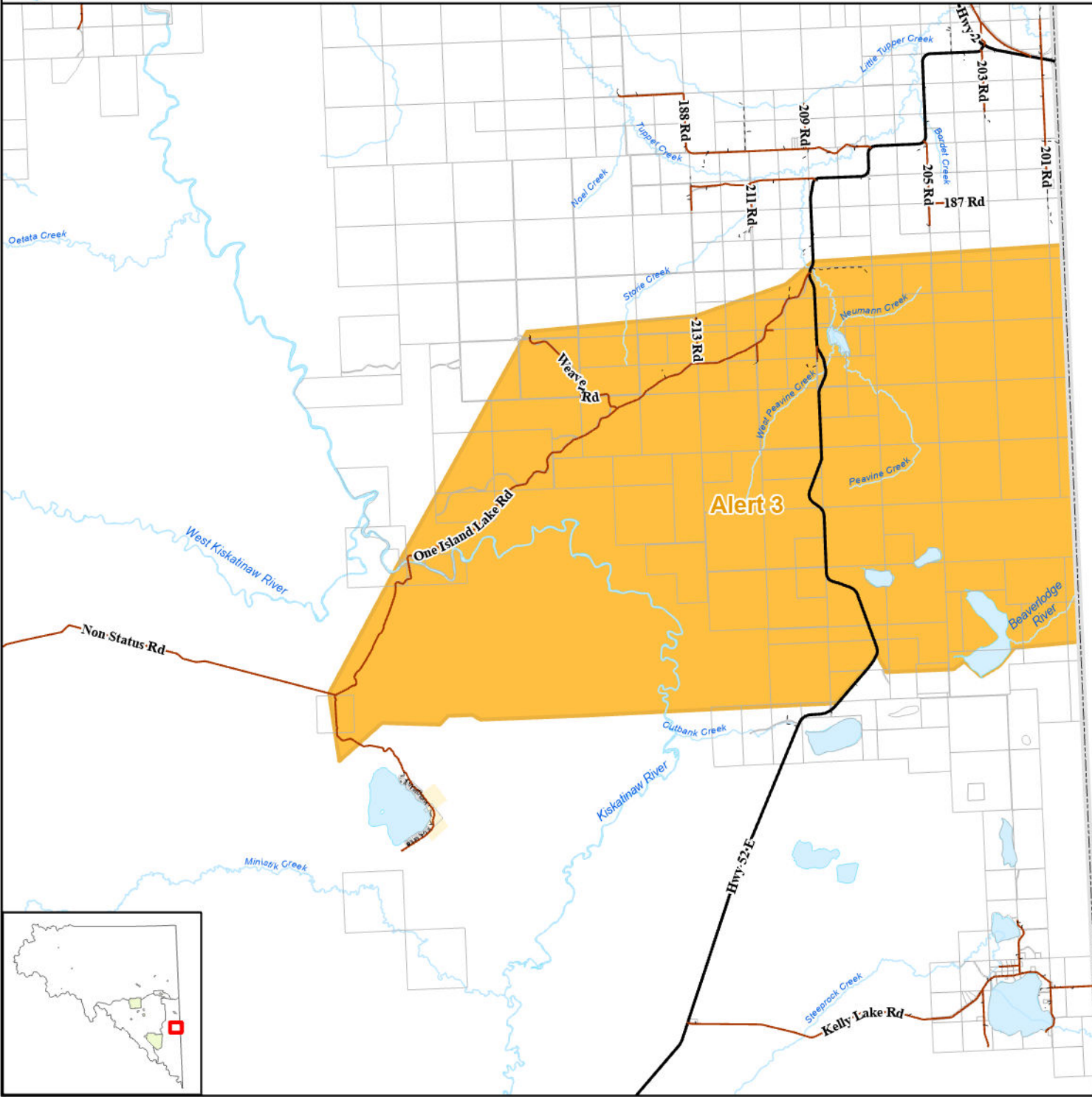

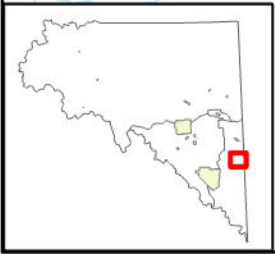
