



EVACUATION ALERT #9

Kiskatinaw Wildfire G70422

Electoral Area D

June 18, 2025 @ 0700

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Peace River Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Peace River Regional District has issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following areas:

- Starting 10.5 kms south of Kiskatinaw Pit Rd & Highway 52E Junction
- 14 kms east from Highway 52E to the Alberta Border
- 24 km north along the BC/AB Border
- 10 kms south of One Island Lake Rd & Highway 52E Junction
- 5.8 kms southwest of the Kiskatinaw River
- 9 kms south of the Kiskatinaw River to the junction of Ministike Creek
- 3.7 kms south by southwest until it intersects the Kiskatinaw Pit Road
- 10 km southeast to Highway 52E

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles. If transportation assistance is needed, call 1-800-670-7773.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor www.prrd.bc.ca for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres.
